then go West on Newberry Road (SR26) about 10 miles.

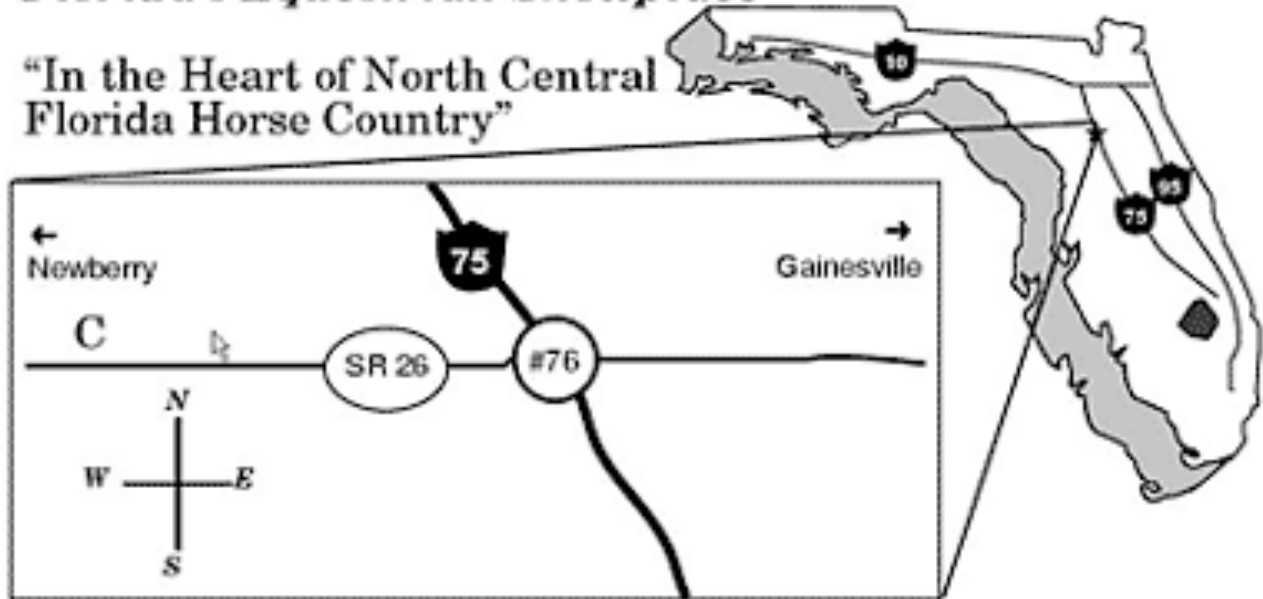
We are on the right.

Federation Entry Agreement

By entering a Federation-licensed Competition and signing this entry blank as the Owner, Lessee, Trainer, Manager, Agent, Coach, Driver, Rider, Handler, Vaulteur or Longeur and on behalf of myself and my principals, representatives, employees and agents, I agree that I am subject to the Bylaws and Rules of The United States Equestrian Federation, Inc. (the "Federation") and the local rules of the THE BAROQUE HORSE REGIONAL CHAMPIONSHIPS. I agree to be bound by the Bylaws and Rules of the Federation and of the competition. I will accept as final the decision of the Hearing Committee on any question arising under the Rules, and agree to release and hold harmless the competition, the Federation, their officials, directors and employees for any action taken under the Rules. I represent that I am eligible to enter and/or participate under the Rules, and every horse I am entering is eligible as entered. I also agree that as a condition of and in consideration of acceptance of entry, the Federation and/or the Competition may use or assign photographs, videos, audios, cable - casts, broadcasts, internet, film, new media or other likenesses of me and my horse taken during the course of the competition for the promotion, coverage or benefit of the competition, sport, or the Federation. Those likenesses shall not be used to advertise a product and they may not be used in such a way as to jeopardize amateur status. I hereby expressly and irrevocably waive and release any rights in connection with such use, including any claim to compensation, invasion of privacy, right of publicity, or to misappropriation. The construction and application of Federation rules are governed by the laws of the State of New York, and any action instituted against the Federation must be filed in New York State. See GR908.4

Federation Release, Assumption of Risk, Waiver, and Indemnification

This document waives important legal rights. Read it carefully before signing.

I AGREE in consideration for my participation in this Competition to the following:

I AGREE that "the Federation" and "Competition" as used herein includes the Licensee and Competition Management, as well as all of their officials, officers, directors, employees, agents, personnel, volunteers and Federation affiliates.

I AGREE that I choose to participate voluntarily in the Competition with my horse, as a rider, driver, handler, vaulteur, longeur, lessee, owner, agent, coach, trainer, or as parent or guardian of a junior exhibitor. I am fully aware and acknowledge that horse sports and the Competition involve inherent dangerous risks of accident, loss, and serious bodily injury including broken bones, head injuries, trauma, pain, suffering, or death. ("Harm").

I AGREE to hold harmless and release the Federation and the Competition from all claims for money damages or otherwise for any Harm to me or my horse and for any Harm of any nature caused by me or my horse to others, even if the Harm arises or results, directly or indirectly, from the negligence of the Federation or the Competition.

I AGREE to expressly assume all risks of Harm to me or my horse, including Harm resulting from the negligence of the Federation or the Competition.

I AGREE to indemnify (that is, to pay any losses, damages, or costs incurred by) the Federation and the Competition and to hold them harmless with respect to claims for Harm to me or my horse, and for claims made by others for any Harm caused by me or my horse while at the Competition. I have read the Federation Rules about protective equipment, including GR801 and, if applicable, EV114, and I understand that I am entitled to wear protective equipment without penalty, and I acknowledge that the Federation strongly encourages me to do so while WARNING that no protective equipment can guard against all injuries. If I am a parent or guardian of a junior exhibitor, I consent to the child's participation and AGREE to all of the above provisions and AGREE to assume all of the obligations of this Release on the child's behalf. I represent that I have the requisite training, coaching and abilities to safely compete in this competition.

I AGREE that if I am injured at this competition, the medical personnel treating my injuries may provide information on my injury and treatment to the Federation on the official USEF accident/injury report form.

I CONSENT to authorizing show management to contact the show veterinarian if, in the opinion of show management, the horse has a serious illness or injury and the owner or trainer is not readily available.

Show Rules, Entry Fees & Stabling Information

1. The 2011 Baroque Horse Regional Championships is a US Equestrian (Federation) licensed competition. Every A/L, Friesian and English Pleasure class offered herein which is covered by the rules and specifications of the current Federation rule book will be conducted and judged in accordance therewith. The rules of the Federation take precedence over the rules of any other association. Exhibitors are encouraged to obtain the current Federation Rule Book, which is available for \$10 (for non-Federation-members) from US Equestrian Federation, 4047 Iron Works Parkway, Lexington, KY 40511, (859) 258-2472. A Federation Steward approved by the Show Committee shall be present to administer these rules at the show.

2. Opportunity Classes: Will be conducted in accordance with USEF rules. There will be no USEF membership requirement or USEF Drug and Medication fees for Opportunity Classes.

3. Rules & Specifications for All Breed Opportunity classes are contained in this booklet and also are available at www.horsedigests.com. If you would like a paper copy, please contact Nancy Nathanson at 805-448-3027. Show rules will be available in the horse show office. USEF/IALHA & IFSHA Show rules are also available at www.Usef.Org.

4. All A/L and Half A/L horses must be registered with or application for registration has been made to IALHA. (See AL101.1 for remainder of rule.) **All Friesian and Part Bred Friesian** horses must have received a certificate of membership from the International Friesian Show Horse Association (IFSHA) (See FR101).

5. The Horse Show Executive Committee reserves the right to itself, to interpret all questions and conditions in regard to, or arising out of, or incident to, the show, without claims for damages or recourse of any kind. Any question not covered in these rules and regulations shall be decided by the Horse Show Executive Committee, their decision to be final. The Horse Show Executive Committee is to consist of Horse Show Manager, Horse Show Secretary, A/L Representative & Friesian Horse Representative.

6. All entries are accepted with the understanding that the Baroque Horse Regional Championships and Canterbury Showplace will not be held responsible for any loss, damage or any injury to any horse exhibited or any article of any kind. All horses shall be under the control and direction of the Show Committee but solely at the risk of the exhibitor, who will be responsible for any loss, damage or injury to any person, animal or property occasioned by him, his agents or employees, or by any animal owned or exhibited by him, and shall indemnify the Federation, Baroque Horse Classic and Canterbury Showplace against any and all loss, damage and liability thus occasioned, including but not limited to any and all legal costs, including attorney fees, which may be incurred as a result thereof. The submitting of an entry form to the Show shall constitute an acceptance by each person signing same of the provisions herein set forth.

7. To be eligible to participate as a rider, driver, handler, vaulter, longeur, owner, lessee, agent, coach or trainer at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Preliminary Level or above, Dressage Competitions, Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Endurance Rides, Reining Competitions, ParaEquestrian Competitions and Vaulting Competitions, persons must be Members of the Federation as provided in Bylaw 201.

8. Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Preliminary Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides. A nonmember may participate as handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, agent, coach or trainer at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a \$30 nonmember registration fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) leadline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) NRHA Endorsed Reining Competitions. 8) Opportunity classes, 9) citizens of other nations who have proof, in English, of current membership in good standing of their own National Federation, 10) USEA beginner novice division; and 11) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes.

9. All owners and exhibitors will be held responsible for any damage incurred by them or their agents to barns or Canterbury Showplace properties on the showgrounds and will be billed accordingly.

10. Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters or farm utility vehicles on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. Violations of this rule will be cause for sanctions against the parent(s), guardian(s) and/or trainer(s)

who are responsible for the child committing the offense. Penalties may include exclusion of the child, parent(s), guardian(s) and/or trainer(s) from the competition grounds for the remainder of the competition and charges being filed against any of the above individuals in accordance with Rule 6. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule

11. Management reserves the right to refuse, accept conditionally, or cancel any entries, and to cancel award prizes, without claims for damages; to change any course, to cancel or combine any unfilled classes; and to change judges or other officials. Class Schedules The Tentative class schedule is included in this booklet. PLEASE NOTE THE FOLLOWING: Management reserves the right to adjust the class schedule and class order. If entries warrant, performance may begin earlier or later than published. Please check with the horse show office for each day's final schedule.

11. Class Fees. All regular classes \$25.00. All Regional Classes \$50.

12. Entries: To be accepted, the entry blank must be COMPLETELY filled out and accompanied by a check covering all fees and proof of a negative Coggins Test dated within six months of show dates for each out-of-state horse. In the case of a minor the entry blank must be signed by the parent or guardian. If there is no trainer, the entry blank **must be signed by the owner.**

13. Closing date: April 22, 2011. Entries must be postmarked by April 22, 2011.

14. Post Entries are accepted with a penalty. of \$25 per horse.

15. Refunds. Entries will only be refunded (less a \$25 processing fee) if a Vet Certificate is received within five days of the event. No refunds on stabling fees. If classes are canceled due to severe weather or other emergency, refunds of entry fees will be made upon written request by the exhibitor within 30 days of the cancellation.

16. Federation Fees. For every Andalusian and Friesian horse participating in any competition recognized by the Federation, a \$15.00 Federation fee will be collected [(\$8.00 is for USEF) and (\$7.00 shall be a drugs and medications fee to provide for research, inspection and enforcement of rules regarding use of medications and drugs; see Federation GR407.1, 2, 3.)].

17. Office Fee. There is an Office Fee of \$25 per horse.

18. A/L Membership. An IALHA non-member fee of \$25 per horse will be assessed if applicable. **A/L Non Member Participation.** An annual Non Member Participation Fee of \$25 per person will be assessed if applicable.

19. Friesian Membership. All owners and horses must be members of IFSHA. All others must either be a member of IFSHA or pay the appropriate non-member fee (\$25 adults/\$20 juniors).

20. Stalls, whether occupied by horses, feed or tack, will be available for a fee of \$100 each for the entire 3 day show, arrival Thursday, May 5, 2011 & \$75 each for the entire 2 day show (arrival Friday, May 6, 2011 **(No first bedding)**)

21. Stall availability. 12' x 12' stalls, with sliding doors, will be available on Thursday, May 5, after 1PM. Early Arrivals **MUST** be pre arranged with Gareth Selwood (262) 325.0283 by April 22, 2011. Early Arrivals will be charged \$35.00 per stall per day.

22. Grounds Fees. The fee for trailering in (Grounds Fee) is \$25 per horse, per day.

23. Bedding is available at the show for \$7.00 per bale. Please order your bedding on the entry blank. Once at the show order bedding at the Horse Show Office. **Feed and hay -** Bring your own.

24. Class Calls. Due to unforeseeable problems with any mechanical device, the PA System and paddock calls must be considered a courtesy. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to be sure that his horse is at the gate at the prescribed time. Every effort will be made to maintain a working PA System to carry class calls, however, no protest will be upheld, nor will any class be changed on the basis of PA malfunctions alone. The two minute gate rule will be strictly enforced. The in gate will be closed two minutes after the first horse enters the ring.

25. Food Service. During the competition food service will be provided on the competition grounds.

26. Dogs must be on leashes no longer than 6 feet.

27. Warm Up Arena is 75 x 175 feet and is composed of sand and clay

28. Covered Show Arena is indoors and is 150 x 250 feet and is composed of sand & clay.

29. Opportunity Classe Specifications – Halter – Open to All Breeds. Classes 224, 227, 228 & 249 To be judged on conformation, quality, way of going, substance and manners.

30. Horse Show Office will be open Thursday, May 5, 2010 from 1 PM to 5 PM. The office will open one hour prior to the first session each day and remain open for 30 minutes after the last class each day. **The Horse Show Office telephone number during the show is (352) 472-6758.**
